The appropriate clause to include in your will is:

“I bequeath to the Taranaki Kiwi Trust for the general purposes of the Trust the sum of \$..... free of all duties payable at the time of my death, and the receipt of the Treasurer for the time being of the said Taranaki Kiwi Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my trustees.”

We recommend that you consult with a solicitor or Public Trust Office when making or changing your will. Taranaki Kiwi Trust is a registered and incorporated charitable trust.
